- Beverly Little Thunder spoke
 - She knows people who are dealing with day-to-day necessities: reliable transportation, heating their home – people who don't have the time to think about climate change – BIPOC community, the elderly, low-income communities
 - Consideration of different cultural practices during meetings creating an open space for all voices to be heard
 - Reminder to consider people that live in far reaches or rural areas
 - Concern about really connecting to BIPOC communities she communicated having discomfort fitting into our meeting space
 - Subcommittee members responded by thanking her for speaking her truth and acknowledgement that what she shared is not an easy thing to share
