Request for Information

1. Establish a Vermont-specific carbon budget
 - a. Recommend changes, if needed, to VT's existing emissions inventory
2. Review and comprehensively identify implementation and policy mechanisms
3. Model existing and proposed emission control scenarios
4. Identify gaps and technology needs (R&D)
5. Identify financing/revenue options
6. Develop a policy model for Short-Term, Interim and Long-Term Obligations
7. Establish the value of carbon (social cost of carbon)
 - a. Economic considerations beyond direct cost all should be evaluated
8. Propose an emissions tracking and reporting frameworks



Moving from RFI to RFP

1. Agree that the VCC does not need to develop a technical model for how to achieve VT's emissions reduction targets
2. Focus this RFP on the specific technical services needed to meet GHG targets (highlighted on previous slide)
3. Work with Subcommittees to:
 - a. develop a clear statement of work
 - b. finalize the tasks and deliverables
 - c. develop clear ranking criteria
4. Hear from other Subcommittees in April on other services needed to advance work
