Pursuant to 3 VSA §2311 (a), please find the 2023 Annual State Outcomes Report which is available as an online Clear Impact scorecard at <u>https://embed.clearimpact.com/Scorecard/Embed/71055</u>. Specific to this year's report, please note the following items:

- 38 indicators show a positive trend, 22 show a negative trend, and 6 show a neutral trend.
- The outcomes "Vermont has a prosperous economy" and "Vermont has open, effective, and inclusive government" have the highest concentration of positive trending indicators while the outcomes "Vermonters are healthy" and "Vermont is a safe place to live" have the highest concentration of negative trending indicators.
- The "genuine progress indicator (GPI)" and "percentage of high school seniors with plans for education, vocational training, or employment" indicators have not been updated for some time. GPI is no longer being calculated as of 2018 and the data related to the senior survey that is traditionally done every two years by the Vermont Student Assistance Corporation is not available.
- The Administration is doing work internally to identify indicators that we would like to remove, update, and add. We expect to submit a proposal for consideration to the Government Accountability Committee by the deadline of March 1 set in 3 VSA §2311 (c).
