September 7, 2023 – 10:00 a.m.**

**ITEM 1. MOTION TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS RELATED TO VAST  
TRAIL NETWORK REPAIR**  
Presentation by Senator Kitchel

Senator Kitchel made the following motion, seconded by Representative Lanpher:

**Moved:** a motion as proposed in the Emergency Board’s meeting materials for Item 1 (as detailed below):

“In recognition of the July 2023 flood disaster, as declared in Executive Order No. 03-23 and the need to repair the extensive damage to the snow mobile trail network in advance of the upcoming snowmobile tourism season, a motion is made, pursuant to 32 V.S.A. Secs. 133(b) and 706(2) to transfer the \$750,000 that was appropriated in 2022 Acts and Resolves No. 185, Sec. G.300(c)(3)(B) to the Department of Forests, Parks and Recreation for a grant to the Vermont Association of Snow Travelers (VAST) to fund flood-impacted trail repair measures.”

The motion was passed unanimously.

With no other business, Senator Cummings made a motion to adjourn, seconded by both Senator Kitchel and Representative Lanpher. The motion was passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:17 a.m.
